 - Must must be a chip, NOT a pitch, blade, etc

 - Must display proper L - Y Technique
 - Ball must land and stay on the Green

 - placing clubs in proper place while hitting
 - scoring accurately and honestly
- All PK members must display proper conduct consistent with our PK code of conduct, displaying sportsmanship/etiquette while on the golf course. As well as knowing when to play, where to stand, and having all equipment to play the course.
